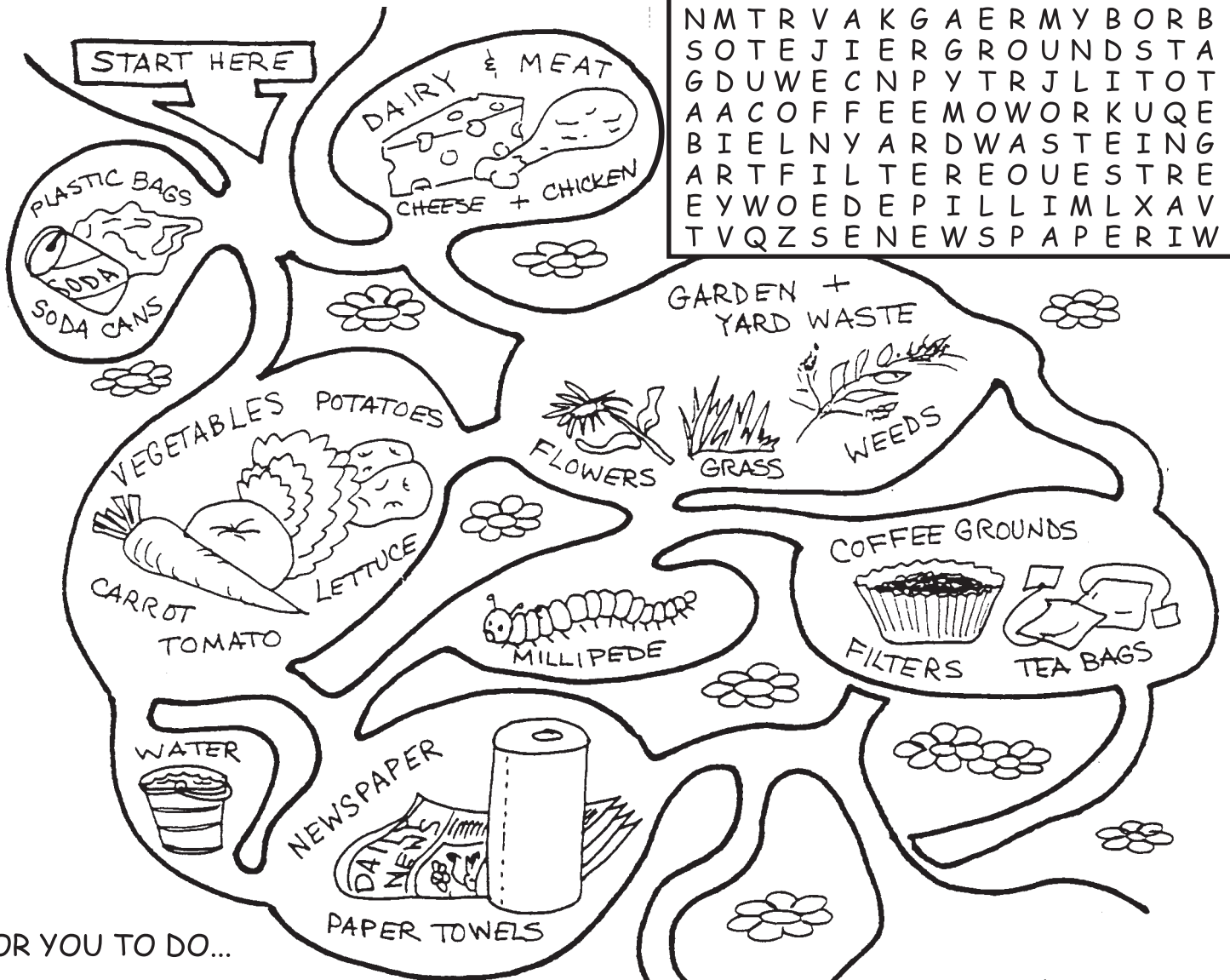


# LET'S MAKE COMPOST!
